**1. Upgrade the physical server (not recommended)**



**2. Upgrade to virtual server (more sustainable)**



**3. Cloud migration (ideal option)**

Consider the needs of your business and choose the best option.

Backup your current data for migration.



04

Testing and validation of current applications to make sure they function correctly.



05

Cutover to chosen option.

Training for employees on new server environment.
